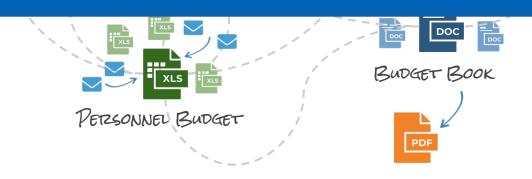

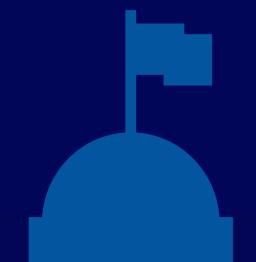

A Multi-Year Capital Plan

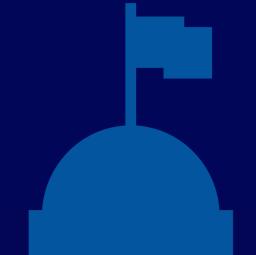
An up-to-date and dynamic multi-year capital plan is essential to the future financial health of an organization and the continued delivery of services to citizens and businesses.

- Infrastructure, technology, and major equipment are the physical foundation for providing services to constituents
- Capital planning is critical to water, sewer, transportation, sanitation, and other essential public services. It is also an important component of a community's economic development program and strategic plan
- A capital plan should cover a period of at least three years, preferably five or more

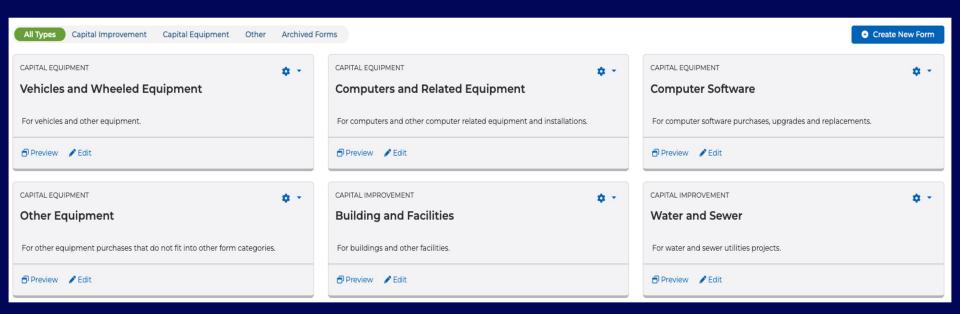


Collecting Capital Requests

- Multiple forms for each Project Type
- Unique questions based requirements of each project type

- Set a deadline for submissions



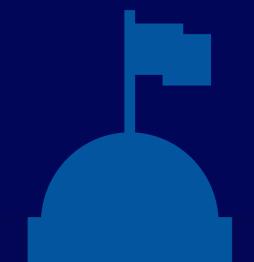




Use cloud-based programs make it easier to collect and review requests.

Collect financial and nonfinancial data to bring requests to life

- Ask for narratives, images, attachments, timelines, and geographic locations
- Capital cost categories
- Funding sources
- Savings and revenues
- Capital vs operating costs





Golf Course Club House Remodel

The clubhouse is where public golfers spend up to 25 percent of their time during the total golf experience, but at private courses, this number can be as high as 50 percent. Stands to reason that if you want to create lasting (favorable) impressions that can ultimately lead to incremental revenue, customers need to "connect" with the space.

Maximize space. Proper space planning plays a large role in whether a clubhouse will drive or drag revenue opportunities. Experienced-based, "golf smart" space planning allows design teams to properly organize and size interior spaces, thus maximizing operational efficiencies and creating more opportunities for customer enjoyment.

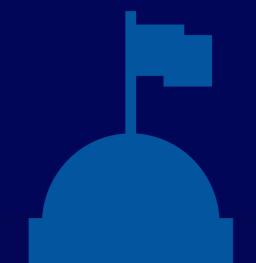

Require your departments to assign a priority to each request Rather than using categories (urgent, wish list, etc.), have department heads assign a numerical value on a ranked list (#1, #2, #3, etc.)

→ This provides a uniform system throughout the organization and makes it easy to compare apples-to-apples

Ranking capital requests helps the finance team determine the priority of requests when budget planning. Drag and drop requests from the 'Unranked Requests" list to the "Ranked Request" list. 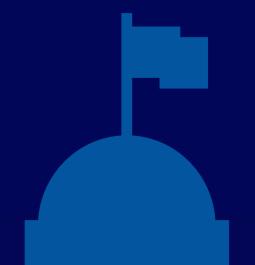

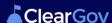




Organizational Priority

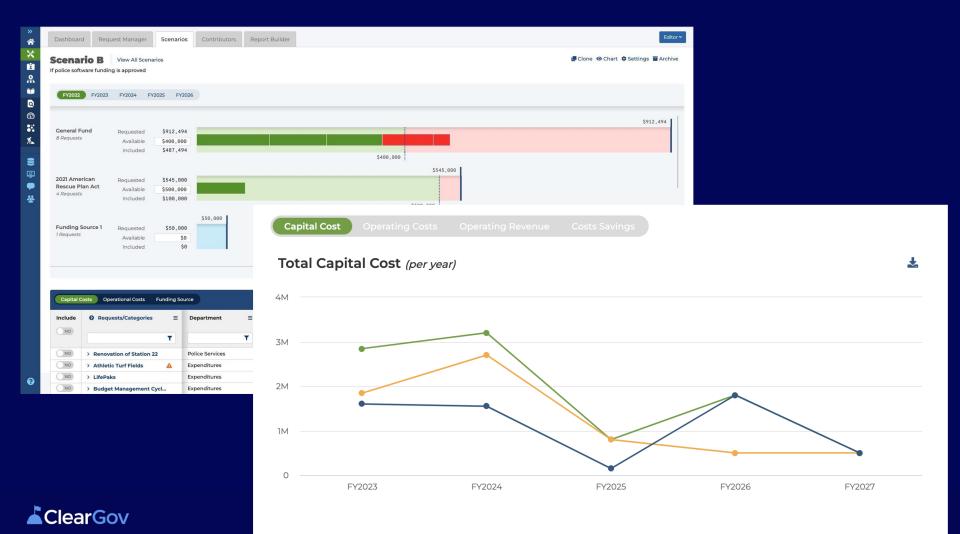


Prepare and Provide Different Budget/Funding Options

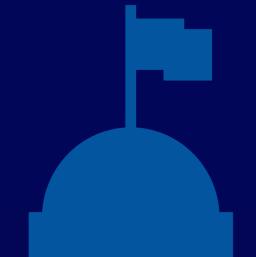
Budgeting and decision making processes concerning capital projects often entail greater complexity than the Operating Budget.

- Make it clear what is available from each funding source and what the project impacts will be (makes it easy to see what tips you over into the red)
- Save and compare your capital budget versions (like your Operating Budget)
- Compare your multi-year scenarios

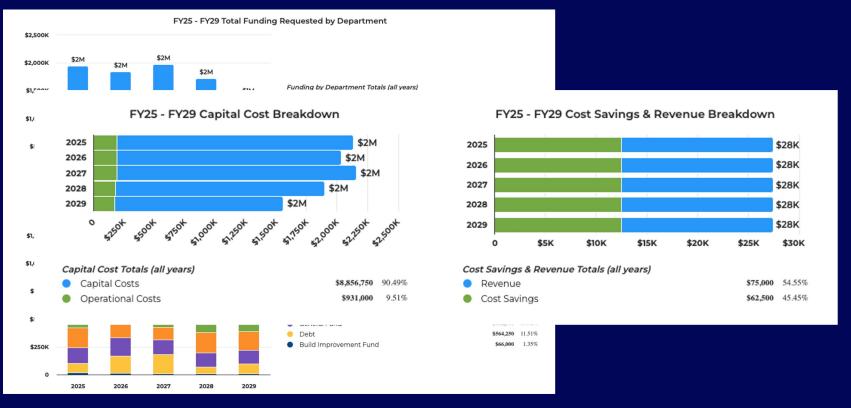


Capital Budget Reporting

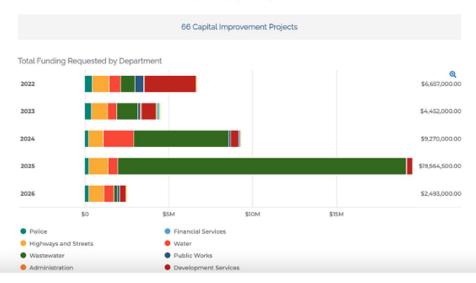

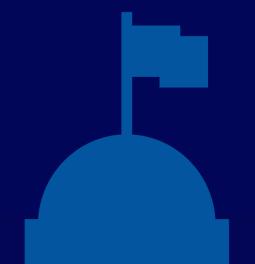

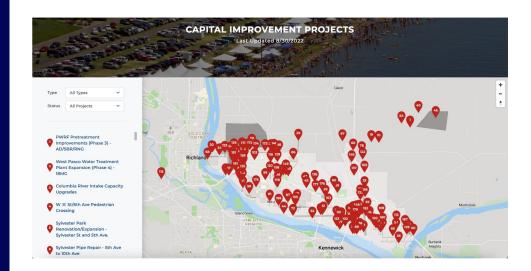

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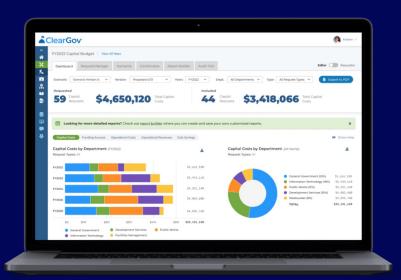


Scale of 1-10: How critical is it that your citizens understand the use of tax dollars for your capital projects?
