MEMBERSHIP LEVELS

Associate Member Annual Dues: \$120

Any individual who is interested in the principles and practices of government finance and is not eligible for the Government Member level.

Government Member Annual Dues: \$75

Any public official or employee who is elected or employed by a local government unit, school district, or agency in a position related to finance, accounting, auditing, budgeting, treasury, data processing, pension, or other fiscal capacity.

Academic Member Annual Dues: \$25

Full-time faculty member who provides course instruction in finance or public administration at accredited institutions of higher learning.

Retired Member Annual Dues: \$25

Any person retired from a position that qualified for government membership, (and not employed in a field that qualifies for associate membership).

Student Member Annual Dues: FREE

Any student enrolled in an institution of higher learning and not yet gainfully employed.
